### *Estate Planning Fee Structure*

Brittle & Brittle P.C. offers an initial consultation for only \$75. During the consultation, our attorneys can help you decide which type of estate planning tool is right for you.

Estate planning cases are generally handled on a flat-fee basis, after the consultation fee. If the matter is complex or requires services outside of the standard document preparation, we may handle your case on an hourly basis instead. Check with our office for current hourly rates.

Brittle & Brittle P.C. has structured three flat-fee “packages,” based on a client’s level of estate planning needs. The flat fee includes as many in-office or phone consultations necessary to finalize the documents. Fixed fees involving creation of trust instruments include up to two hours of the attorney’s time for funding the trust. Any time beyond the two hours will be billed at then-current hourly rates. Half of the fixed fee is due in advance; the balance is due within ten days of delivery of the draft documents to the client.

Package #1: Preparation of a Will only. Flat-fee of \$400 per person or \$600 per couple.

Package #2: Preparation of a Will, Durable Power of Attorney (appoints a person to make financial decisions for you in the event you are incapacitated), and an Advance Directive (appoints a person to make health care decisions for you in the event you are incapacitated). Flat-fee of \$600 per person or \$1,000 per couple.

Package #3: Preparation of a Will, Durable Power of Attorney, Revocable Living Trust, and Advance Directive. This package is used when clients have complex estates or wish to avoid probate. Flat-fee of \$1,500 per person or \$2,400 per couple.

Miscellaneous: For an additional \$95, preparation of an Appointment of Person to Make Decisions Concerning Disposition of Remains (appoints someone to ensure that your wishes regarding your funeral service, burial, etc. are followed after your death).
